


AC37 | Valve for R290 & R600 Cans

- IMPORTANT: THIS PRODUCT IS TO BE USED BY ONLY LICENCED AND EXPERIENCED REFRIGERATION CONTRACTORS
- IMPORTANT: NO SMOKING, NO NAKED FLAME, NO SPARK
- IMPORTANT: REMOVE THE VALVE FROM CYLINDER WHEN NOT IN USE
- IMPORTANT: THE VALVE WILL BE INSTALL ON AN EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE GAS CYLINDER. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE WARNINGS MAY RESULT IN AN EXPLOSION OF FIRE THAT MAY CAUSE PROPERTY DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH



### **1. INTRODUCTION**


AC37 is a single stage value to be used with Ambro or Bromic disposable R290 (1811290 or 1811226) & R600 (1811600 or 1811227) refrigerant cylinders. The value was designated with 2 connections:

- 7/16"-28 UNEF Female
- 1/4" SAE Male

The kit is fitted with 1 x O-Ring at the connection to cylinder. Replace O-ring with suitable alternative (Material: EPDM, Size: OD 11.2mm, Thickness 1.78mm)

### WARNINGS PRIOR TO USE:

- R290 and R600 are flammable gases. Refer to the product information for safety information about the use, handling and storage requirements
- The AC37 valve shall be used only in areas free from ignition sources and used in areas that are well ventilated.
- Ensure product is defect free before use by checking operation of handle, and dam age to sealing threads including the O-ring
- Threads must be clean and free of all debris, oil, grease etc. before connection of valve
- Always work on a non-flammable base
- Always wear gloves and other appropriate protective equipment during operation
- Do not inhale any fumes
- In case of Leaking gas fire: DO NOT extinguish, unless leak can be stopped safely
- Keep out of reach of Children
- Refrigerant emission to the air/climate is prohibited
- Prior to fitting the AC37 valve to a cylinder, ensure the handle is fully screwed out by turning in the anti-clockwise direction. This is to ensure the valve is in the fully closed position before attaching to the disposable refrigerant cylinder.

### 2. INSTALLATION

- Ensure the valve is fully closed (handle was fully screwed out by turning the handle anticlockwise.)
- Inspect the O-ring for damage only use this valve if the O-ring is in good condition or replace with a new O-ring.
- Install the valve with Ambro or Bromic R290 (1811290 or 1811226) & R600 (1811600 or 1811227) cylinders by screwing in the valve by turning clockwise.
- Install 1/4 SAE connection with ¼" BSP copper tube or hose (depending on user application).

## **3. OPERATION**

# \Lambda WARNING:

BEFORE OPERATION, MAKE SURE THE SURROUNDING ATMOSPHERE IS FREE FROM ANY POTENTIAL IGNITION SOURCES AND AREA IS WELL VENTILATED

- Prior to fitting the AC37 valve to a cylinder, ensure the handle is fully screwed out by turning in the anti-clockwise direction.
- Slowly screw handle down until desired flow rate
- Close the valve handle fully screw out in anti-clockwise direction.
- Remove the AC37 valve from the cylinder when not in use





WARNING: DO NOT STORE CYLINDERS WITH THE AC37 VALVE FITTED

WARNING: BE SURE THAT THE VALVE ON THE GAS CYLINDER HAS BEEN SHUT OFF (HANDLE FULLY SCREWED OUT) FIRMLY BEFORE DISCONNECTION
