
All Bromic hose assemblies must be installed in accordance with Bromic installation instructions and installation will also need to conform with any applicable local, state or national standards. Installation which is not in conformance with those instructions and standards will void the warranty.

Refer to the hose label for the tightening requirements of the connector. Ensure not to over tighten the connector. The connector is also subjected to tensile or compressive force and must not be twisted or kinked.

During the installation the water hose assembly is to be installed free from kinks and excessive tight bends. For minimum bend radius (see Table 1). When installing the connector, ensure the bend radius is as large as possible where movement is possible.
